DRESSAGE BIT CHECK - Job Checklist

What To Bring	ChairWater and snacks
Check In	 Check in on Eventing Volunteers app Pick up materials: Bit Check sign, measuring stick, Bit Check Tote (gloves, hand sanitizer, binoculars, halter/lead rope), Bit Check box (Order-of-Go, radio). Head down to the dressage warm-up area and set up the Bit Check station. Review the Order-of-Go for each ring to see which levels are in which ring, how many competitors there are, any missing numbers, etc.
On the Job	 For each rider: Use new glove for each horse. Check bit (refer to guidelines for acceptable bits). Check whip length. Check spur length. Check off rider number on Order-of-Go. If horse is wearing a bonnet, ask the rider to return to the Bit Check station after the test. Remove the bonnet and check that there is nothing in the ears to muffle sound. Review Order-of-Go list for no-shows: Look for riders who have not yet come over. Ask Secretary if a rider has scratched. Ask the Announcer to make an announcement for these riders to get their bits checked. Notify the TD if a rider has not had the bit checked.
Check Out	 Return materials to office. Throw away used gloves. Check out on <u>Eventing Volunteers app</u>
